We pay \$750,000 to end dispute

THE Sunshine Coast council has settled a long-running legal battle over a Mooloolaba car park after 10 years.

Developer Graeme Juniper will be paid \$750,000 after he was unable to go ahead with a redevelopment of the Brisbane Road car park in the wake of community protests. The land had been resumed by the council for parking.

In 2004, the council conferred high-rise development rights to Mr Juniper.
