TOURISM Sunshine Coast will shut its doors on June 30, but the Coast council-run group set to take over is yet to hire key staff to lead the area's \$2.4 billion industry.

Fallout after \$100m collapse

KLEENMAID liquidator Deloitte has been accused of picking over the bones of Kleenmaid victims after demanding money from creditors of the failed whitegoods giant.

One former Kleenmaid contractor, who claimed to be out of pocket by \$43,000 following the company's \$100 million collapse in April last year, has now been hit with an immediate payment order for \$119,000.

Deloitte partner and Kleenmaid liquidator Richard Hughes told the Daily that he was pursuing up to 15 separate claims against companies he alleged had received "preferential payments" from Kleenmaid.

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
